**TRUCK MUSTER INFORMATION FOR VEHICLE EXHIBITORS.**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Hunter Valley Vintage Truck Muster is open to all types of historic commercial vehicles over 25 years of age. E.g. trucks, buses, utes, vans, military & fire vehicles, tractors etc (Regardless of size, make or condition.) The Truck Muster display will be held at the old J&A Brown mine site at Hebburn St, Pelaw Main, near Kurri Kurri. The truck muster display site is at the northern end of the Richmond Vale Railway Museum line.

During the Truck Muster weekend there will also be a toy & model show, historic train rides, vintage farm machinery display, guided tours of the historic mine and power station sites.

There is no entry fee for vehicle exhibitors and their immediate families; however enthusiasts and the public not displaying commercial vehicles/exhibits at the truck muster are subject to the railway museums usual admission fees. Admission fee's are available on the railway museums web site. [www.richmondvalerailwaymuseum.org](http://www.richmondvalerailwaymuseum.org) Train rides, entry to the railway museum and the toy & model show is also free of charge for truck show exhibitors. Vehicle exhibitors are welcome to camp on site (free of charge) showers are only available at the Richmond Vale Museum, but toilets are available at both the railway museum site and the truck muster site. Power is very limited.

A Saturday night Truck Muster dinner is going to be held at the Kurri Kurri Bowling Club, cost \$25 per adult. Children's meals can be organised for the Truck Muster dinner, please contact us for costs and details. Tickets to the Truck Muster dinner are limited first in best dressed. RSVP for dinner no later than Friday 06/05/11 Return transport from the truck show site to the Kurri Kurri Bowling Club will be via vintage bus if required.

For those not wanting to go to the Saturday night dinner, Kurri Kurri has a variety of take away food including McDonalds, KFC and pizza etc (Fuel and auto parts are also available within a few minutes of the display site.)

A Sunday morning breakfast is planned for vehicle exhibitors and following breakfast a short commercial vehicle road run will take place. The road run will be back at the Truck Muster display area before the public is on site.

*Please note:* That vehicles are only to be driven on site by licenced drivers & vehicle without current registration or permits are not to be driven on site, must be static display only. For safety reasons the site speed limit is 5 kmph. Vehicles are not to be moved around the display site whilst the public are in attendance. A tilt tray will be available to assist with the unloading of vehicles if required and will be crewed by HVCCVC members only. We expect that a new dual height loading ramp will also be available for the exhibitors use. The HVCCVC & RVRM takes no responsibility for any loss, injury or damages during the Truck Muster weekend.

Please note: That the vehicle exhibitors entry for the truck muster is at Hebburn St, Pelaw Main and not at the Richmond Vale Railway Museum main gate, the railway museum main gate is for public entry only.
